Attached please find a scholarship application package that is being offered by the Michael D. Richardson Foundation Inc.

This Foundation was organized in 2007 to honor the memory of Michael D. Richardson, a thirty-year-old lifelong resident of Rockaway New York.

He was a graduate of Howard University and was attending Georgetown University where his goal was to become a lawyer. His dream was cut short when he was tragically murdered on June 27, 2007, in Washington D.C.

Please read all the requirements carefully and make sure you qualify.

This Scholarship will be awarded to the student(s) who fulfill the requirements, and their results will be graded by the Scholarship Committee who at their discretion will determine the recipients.

The Scholarship is based on outstanding Academic Achievement and Community Service. It will be awarded upon fulfilling eligibility criteria such as: graduating High School and Enrollment into College/University. (See Application). The Committee in its sole discretion will evaluate all applicants based on the criteria enclosed and determine the eligible recipients of the Scholarship Award.

The Scholarship will be awarded for each of the four years of the student's enrollment in College/University once they fulfill the criteria of notifying the Foundation by mailing in a Transcript and Fall Schedule.

Eligible students are responsible for informing and submitting their grades each year to the Foundation to annually secure their four-year scholarship.

P.S. Please note that scholarship awards are distributed at the conclusion of each academic school year after the foundation has received your grades and verified that all requirements have been fulfilled.

- **If we do not hear from you, your scholarship for the upcoming year will be forfeited.**
- **If we do not receive your grades, transcript, and fall program by August 1—both for the upcoming year and for each subsequent year required to maintain your scholarship—your scholarship will be forfeited.**

 - *1 letter may also be submitted from your Church Pastor, Community Service Director, School Club Director, or any In-School Service Activity that you are involved in***(These recommendations are to attest to the candidate's moral fiber and character. No relatives may submit a letter of recommendation.)**

All letters of recommendation must be provided on organization letterhead with the title of the writer.
